- Short Bible Study every Wednesday at 7:30 p.m.

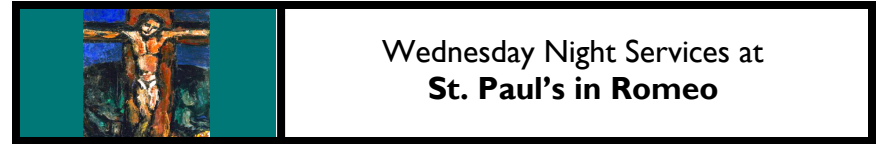

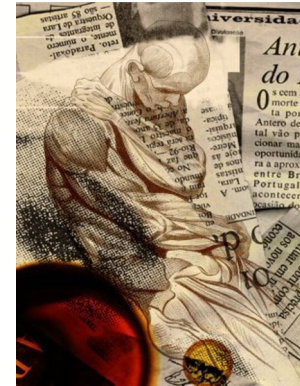
